- The entry fee is \$10.00; an entry consists of one or two 10-22 oz bottles. Oversized and unusual bottles are allowed as long as they meet the rules for labeling.
- An awards ceremony will be held afterwards to announce the winners in each category and Best of Show.
- This competition is open to brewers age 21 or older.
